

The great thing about garden furniture is its low maintenance, however all furniture benefits from some care and maintenance. We recommend you follow the advice in our care guide as there are a few things you can do to make sure your purchases look good for years to come.

Rattan Garden Furniture


Most of our garden furniture is made from hand woven synthetic rattan, this gives the same look as natural rattan but is more weather resistant and requires less maintenance. To clean simply wash with soapy water when needed.

If possible store your garden furniture in a dry place over the winter, furniture left out in frost or snow or exposed to strong sunshine can become brittle or stiff. Extremes of temperature can reduce the appearance of your furniture.

If furniture is left out in rainy weather, tip or tilt to help water drain off more quickly.

Glass Surfaces

To prevent scratching and staining, we recommend using coasters on your outdoor glass table top. Do not place very hot or very cold items, such as pans or barbecues, directly on the glass surface. Extreme temperature differences over small areas can cause damage, which could in turn lead to shattering.





Sunshine

All but the hardiest of materials will be subject to fading and colour loss in strong sunlight. To help maintain the original colour of your garden furniture try to cover, store or move your furniture away from the strongest afternoon rays whenever possible. It is important to protect glass top tables from extreme heat as temperature differences can cause damage, which could in turn lead to shattering.

Parasols

Do not put parasols up in the wind or leave out in the rain. If parasols get wet leave them open to dry out. When not in use store away, this is particularly important in high winds and winter months. Always store parasols in a dry, airy place, particularly in winter to help prevent mould or mildew forming.

Cushions

To keep your cushions looking good keep them inside when not in use, try not to leave them outside overnight or in the rain. Wipe dry if damp.

Weather Covers

To prolong the life of your garden furniture and protect it from the weather we recommend using weatherproof covers to keep your furniture in good condition all year round. When storing under cover leave room for air to circulate to help prevent mould.
